Everybody's Talking!

Longest birthday: With the help of time zones, Sven Hagemeyer from Germany managed to make his birthday last 46 hours—almost two days! This record-breaking move took Hagemeyer from Auckland, New Zealand, to Brisbane, Australia, before he landed in Honolulu, Hawaii (US). His extended celebration resulted in a Guinness World Record for the longest birthday. Hagemeyer took the title from a Pakistani woman who previously had stretched her special day to 35 hours. While a lot of travelling was involved to break the record, Hagemeyer didn't have much time to sightsee because he spent most of his birthday on planes.

Lego masterpieces: If you think finishing a 100-piece Lego set is a feat worth celebrating, try bumping that up to one hundred thousand pieces! The "Piece of Peace" exhibition, which took place in Hong Kong, was a hot spot for world-class Lego reproductions of World Heritage sites. Lego artists spent many hours building near-exact replicas of the Sagrada Familia church in Barcelona (Spain), the Great Wall of China, India's Taj Mahal, and the Itsukushima Shinto Shrine (Japan). The smaller displays totaled about 800 pieces, while the largest used thousands.

Keep calm, take pictures: Keeping the subject calm is a challenge for wildlife photographers, but take away the human presence and there's no problem! Will Burrard-Lucas, of England, developed a remote-controlled camera buggy called BeetleCam that allows his camera to get up close and personal with lions, hyenas, and big cats without being in danger himself. This innovative shutterbug tested his first camouflaged camera on wheels in Tanzania, then used a more protective version in the Masai Mara National Reserve, Kenya, then moved to Zambia for more. He brought home stunning results. In many instances, the wild beasts' curiosity led them right up to the gadget for a perfect shot.

Rescue roach: Although cockroaches are widely considered pests, one day they could help in emergency rescue situations. Scientists at North Carolina State University (US) have created a new technology called "BioBots." The team equipped cockroaches with electronic sensors in tiny backpacks that show where they are burrowing underground. While the bugs explore, rescue teams can use the technology to control the movements of the insects. Someday the bugs could help detect victims trapped under rubble following an earthquake.


