Crazy collection: There are various items people can get hooked on collecting, such as teacups, dolls, stamps, coins, and comic books, etc. However, a man from Qingdao City in China's Shandong Province collects something a little different - Transformer models. So far, Zhang Wei has amassed over 380 models of various Transformer figures, such as Optimus Prime, Bumblebee, and Red Spider, which line the shelves of his home. It is estimated that the collection is worth about \$32,000 (US). Luckily, his wife Zhang Tsai doesn't mind, although she finds it a bit challenging to do the dusting.

Tiny art: You wouldn't think that a toothpick could become a work of art, but a German woman named Ragna Reusch-Klinkenberg has done just that. An artist who likes carving things from wood, Reusch-Klinkenberg uses a tiny knife to carve figures out of the tops of toothpicks. She then paints them with a tiny brush. The figures might be of people, animals, or objects, such as a toothbrush. She even carved a series of people dressed in black (a choir) being conducted by a choir leader. While she has become famous for her toothpick carvings, Reusch-Klinkenberg often uses a chainsaw to make statues from blocks of wood.

Crow gifts: Most people find crows to be somewhat annoying with their constant cawing. However, Gabi Mann from Seattle, Washington (US), made friends with some crows and she received gifts in return. It seems that Gabi liked sharing her lunch with the crows and then started putting food out in the bird feeder for them. The crows learned to wait for their dinners. Then, an amazing thing happened. The crows started leaving gifts for Gabi - things like earrings, beads, Lego pieces, and screws. It must be the crows' way of saying "Thank You" for the food.

Fern art: After seeing the artwork of Helen Ahpornsiri, viewers will never again look at a fern the same way. Ahpornsiri takes pieces of different types of ferns which she presses and then arranges into breathtaking pictures of creatures from nature, such as bees, birds, and bugs. The completed works are so beautiful and delicate that they look almost like they've been embroidered with colorful thread. A graduate of Falmouth University in Cornwall, England, Ahpornsiri had been collecting and pressing colorful ferns for some time and finally decided to use them artistically.
