Molten wedding: Getting wedding photos taken usually means finding some nice gardens or a scenic view as a backdrop. A couple in the Philippines, Arlo De La Cruz and Maica Nicerio-De La Cruz, took those ideas one step further: they had their wedding pictures taken in front of Mount Mayon, an active volcano that was erupting at the time. With ash and lava as the backdrop, the newly married couple posed for photographer Franklyn Nebreja. The eruption had been expected, so people in the area were on high alert, but everything went smoothly for the couple's wedding day celebrations.

Round trip: Visitors to the state of Tennessee (US) might want to check out a trek through the woods to a waterfall called Machine Falls. Located near the city of Tullahoma in the Short Springs Natural Area, hikers can take a 1.6-mile round trip trail that, for the most part, is flat with easy footing. Toward the end of the trail, hikers have to be little more careful because the path descends into a gorge. The waterfall spills over several tiers into a creek bed that visitors can wade through, and there are boulders to scramble on or to use as seating for an outdoor meal.
