Everybody's Talking!

Lost stork: EkoLogiczna, a Polish environmental organization, placed a GPS tracker on a white stork named Kajtek. The group wanted to learn about the bird's migration activities, and the GPS was supposed to help with that. At first, everything went as expected as Kajtek flew for about 6,000 kilometers (3,728 miles). But on the trip back, instead of returning straight to Poland, the bird hung around the Blue Nile Valley in eastern Sudan for a couple of months, taking 25-kilometer (15.5 mi.) trips in various directions before the signal was lost. As it turns out, a thief had removed the SIM card from the GPS and placed it into a phone. EkoLogiczna got a bill for 10,000 PLN. No one knows what happened to Kajtek.

Towering falls: There may be many artificial waterfalls in this world, but few are as spectacular as the one on the Liebian International Plaza skyscraper in the city of Guiyang, Guizhou (China). Measuring 108 meters (354 feet) high, it cascades down the side of a 121-meter (397-ft.) building. The water, which is pumped from an enormous underground storage unit, is recycled from tap and rain water. The flowing water sparkles in the sun and causes a rainbow. It's a delight for those using the building's services, which include a hotel, offices, and stores. The waterfall is only turned on for special occasions.

New life to trees: Ash trees in Montréal, Québec (Canada), have been hard hit by the emerald ash borer, a beetle that kills this type of tree. Seeing the trees die is heartbreaking, but a non-profit organization has found a way to lessen the blow. Les Atelier d'Antoine teaches young people how to work with wood. One of its projects is making furniture, such as chairs, tables, and benches, out of the ash wood. The organization has provided beautiful wooden chairs and tables to a library, along with comfortable, unique benches for parks. Because ash is a hardwood and finishes nicely, it's perfect for these purposes.

Beautiful cat: Coby the cat is famous, with a popularity most of us can only dream about. This British Shorthair has pure white fur that contrasts with his steely blue eyes, resulting in a rather startling but compelling portrait of feline beauty. How do people know about Coby? Owner Rebecca Schefkind of San Francisco, California (US), regularly posts photos of Coby on Instagram, and the kitty has amassed over a million followers. She started the postings just for fun, with no idea that viewers would fall in love with her pet's unique look.
