Everybody's Talking!

Baby talk: Mother gorillas use a form of non-vocal motherese with their babies, not unlike humans who use baby talk and gestures with their newborns. German researcher Eva Maria Luef, from the Max Planck Institute for Evolutionary Anthropology in Leipzig, Germany led a team of scientists who observed the facial expressions and hand signals of active western lowland gorillas when they interacted with their babies. They determined the mothers would use touch, stroking and light slapping to communicate with their young, and they repeated these often to reinforce the message. According to Dr. Luef, this shows that the older animal is aware of the infant's immature communication skills.

High tech: In an effort to tackle corruption in one of the country's most corrupt departments, the Bolivian government is requiring its customs officers to use a high-tech pen, equipped with both a hidden voice recorder and a micro-camera. That way, an agent's job performance can be replayed and, hopefully, suspicious actions detected. Customs director Marlene Ardaya, who will be required to use the special pen herself, explains that the pens will be activated during all working hours, and officials will be selected randomly to have their devices checked.

Costly rental: Those who plan to rent a sports car, such as a BMW, better be sure they know how to drive it. In Chicago, a driver returning the car to the rental kiosk on the third floor of a parking garage lost control of the vehicle. It broke through some wires, flew through the air and landed on top of a Jaguar and a Mercedes. Vicky Baftiri was pulling out of her parking spot when the accident happened. If the BMW hadn't hit the Jag and the Mercedes, Baftiri would have been hit instead. Luckily for everyone involved, no one was hurt.

Really old: New technology and refined dating techniques have now determined that some European cave art is likely to be more than 40,000 years old. "One motif – a faint red dot – in Cantabria, El Castillo, Spain, dates back 40,800 years," explains Dr. Alistair Pike from Bristol University in the United Kingdom. This makes the motif Europe's oldest dated art by at least 4,000 years. Joao Zilhao, a research professor at the University of Barcelona, who worked with Pike, thinks Neanderthals produced the motifs, but at this point he can't prove his theory. According to scientists, tracing origins of abstract thought and behavior helps to understand the human story.
