Everybody's Talking!

Seashells: People who live near a beach and want to renovate their homes don't necessarily have to spend a lot of money on building material if they follow the example of Xiao Yongsheng of Lingshan Island near Qingdao city in China. Yongsheng wanted to update his home, so he started collecting all different shapes and sizes of seashells, from big conches to tiny clamshells. He then covered all surfaces of his home with the shells, creating artistic patterns and mosaics for decoration. Although Yongsheng did the shell decorating for his own interest, his home has attracted the attention of tourists to the island.

Icy climb: Will Gadd, a Canadian ice climber who hails from the town of Canmore, Alberta (CAN), has succeeded in a world first – he climbed the icy cliff beside the famed Horseshoe Falls that straddles the border between the American city of Buffalo and the Canadian city of Niagara Falls. Gadd used ice-climbing equipment to scale the 180-foot (55-meter) icy tower that is only a few feet from the roaring water tumbling over the falls. Each minute, tons of water cascade over the falls at 110 km/h (68 mph), shrouding the area in clouds of mist. It took Gadd eight months to obtain the permit for the feat, which took about an hour to complete.

Soup scent: It seems that an inebriated man in Barnaul, located in south-central Russia, realized he was hungry when he smelled soup coming from somewhere in his 10-story building. To get to the soup, Ivan Ozerov decided to follow the aroma, which was wafting up a ventilation shaft. Unfortunately, he got stuck in the shaft. As he struggled to try to free himself, his pants came down and a sock fell off. He cried for help and someone called firefighters, who had to use sledgehammers to break the wall from the outside. After a while, the firefighters managed to make a hole large enough to pull the man out.

Wild ride: A police officer in China had a wild ride through the streets of Dalian in Liaoning Province as he hung on tight to the top of a taxi. He had pulled the taxi over to do a check on what turned out to be an illegal cab. The cab driver took off in the middle of the inspection. For reasons unknown, the officer thought he might be able to make the driver stop if he jumped on top of the vehicle. No such luck. The driver kept going for about one kilometer (0.6 miles) before swerving off to a pedestrian area, where the officer managed to hop off.


