Everybody's Talking!

Lynx visitors: When you live in Alaska (US), you might not be surprised to see a bear emerge from the bush. But what Tim Newton found on his deck one morning would have amazed anyone. When some odd noises woke him up, he cautiously checked outside and saw a mother lynx, with seven kittens, rabble-raising on his porch. The kittens proved to be a playful bunch, and Newton was able to take lots of pictures of their antics. They didn't sit still much, but he did manage to get one shot of the whole family together during a momentary rest from play.

Chili challenge: If you want to try your luck at a chili-eating competition, check out some of the events held by the Clifton Chilli Club, which holds contests around the United Kingdom. Contestants go through a number of rounds, eating progressively hotter chilies each round, from the relatively tame Red Fresno and Jalapeno peppers to the blistering hot Ghost Orange, Scorpion Red, and Carolina Reaper chilies, with a few in between. If the going gets too tough, competitors can reach for their glass of soothing milk. But if they do, they're disqualified. This definitely is not a contest for the faint of heart!

Bird watching: The Galápagos Islands, about 600 miles (966 kilometers) off the coast of Ecuador, attract many visitors who are interested in seeing the area's biodiversity. However, going there is quite expensive. A more economical destination is Isla de la Plata (Silver Island), which is only about 25 miles (40 kilometers) from the mainland and is part of the Parque Nacional Machalilla. Visitors to this small island are amazed at the diversity of the bird population, many of which are completely comfortable in close proximity to humans. Among the bird species are frigatebirds, pelicans, and blue-footed boobies, who share their home with lizards, sea lions, iguanas, and many more species of wildlife.

Busy as a beaver: There's a lot of truth to the saying "busy as a beaver," especially when considering a bunch of beavers that live in Wood Buffalo National Park in the province of Alberta, Canada. In that park is a beaver dam that measures 850 meters (2,790 ft.) in length. A researcher found the dam in 2007. As parts of it are covered with grass, it is thought that generations of beavers have worked on it since the 1970s. Beavers build dams to form ponds around their dens, keeping them out of reach of wolves, bears, and other predators.
