Everybody's Talking!

Book rescue: There is a library in the Çankaya district of Ankara, Turkey, that may never have existed if not for the foresight of garbage collectors in the area. These workers noticed that many people were throwing out books. Instead of sending them to the dump, they started to collect them. When people got word of this, donations started to come in. Soon, it was necessary to find a place to put all the salvaged books, so the Sanitation Department reopened an abandoned brick factory. Shelves were erected, and lounge furniture installed, and now children, adults, and passersby can stop in to read or borrow from the collection of 6,000 books.

Unique home: Housing in Hong Kong is a problem: there is not enough of it for the huge population, and it's very expensive. To try to ease the shortage of affordable places to live, architect James Law, of James Law Cybertecture, designed living accommodations made of concrete pipe. Called the OPod Tube House, the one- to two-person pipe home is about eight feet in diameter, and contains a kitchen area, a bathroom, and a couch that converts into a bed. These structures install easily and can be stacked. The architect hopes that they may be used as housing in urban spots where people normally wouldn't live, such as in alleys or between buildings.

Paper dresses: A costume designer from North Carolina (US) is so creative that she figured out how to make beautiful ball gowns out of discarded wrapping paper. Olivia Mears hated the idea of throwing out giftwrap after just one use, so she got out the glue and tape, and used lots of imagination to design gowns that look like they belong on fairy-tale princesses. She admits that her gowns might be worn only a few times, but at least the colorful paper is getting another chance to wrap something up! Mears has a history of making clothing out of unusual materials, such as taco wrappers and toilet paper.

Hidden waterfall: An awe-inspiring waterfall in Iceland can only be reached through a crack in a cliff. Called Gljúfrafoss, it is close to another famous waterfall, Seljalandsfoss, in the southwest part of the country. If visitors want to view Gljúfrafoss from above, they can hike up a canyon to the top to take a look. Or, they can wade in a stream through a crack in the rock walls that surround the falls. Although the water is cold, the trek is worth it. Adventurous viewers will be rewarded with a close-up view of the water as it tumbles down the canyon. Visitors are advised to wear waterproof boots and raincoats for this outing!
