Pizza scam: Lawyer Guido Grolle is tired of pizza. That's because 100 of them have been sent to his law office in Dortmund (Germany) over a two-week period, even though he didn't order them. And they keep coming. Grolle has no idea who is sending the pizzas. The prank interferes with his work because of all the text alerts from pizza restaurants to confirm the orders. Police have investigated to no avail, computer experts have ruled out a virus, and Grolle doesn't know of any clients who would be out to get him. If the perpetrator is caught, he or she could possibly be charged with stalking.

Cat story: It's distressing when a pet gets lost, but there is always hope that the furry family member will be found. Sometimes that hope pays off. Sean, Stephanie, and Emily Tuttle lost Raja, their cat, when they were living in the state of Florida (US). After the feline went missing, the family moved to the state of Virginia.
