Feline hero: Bear, a cat whose owner is Professor Dame Sue Black of Stonehaven, Aberdeenshire (Scotland), is a hero these days. That's because he found Rosie Bloom, a neighbor's budgie that had been missing from its cage for six weeks. Rather than making the bird its lunch, the feline brought it home. Professor Black is accustomed to receiving gifts of birds and mice, so she wasn't surprised when Bear walked in the door holding the squawking Rosie Bloom in his mouth. Penny Campbell, the bird's owner, was grateful to be reunited with her pet.

Cat artistry: An artist in Russia is using her pet cat to attract the attention, and perhaps the ire, of art lovers. Imagine Leonardo da Vinci's *Mona Lisa* holding a lovely ginger cat. Or how about Johannes Vermeer's *Girl with the Pearl Earring* with a cat curled up in her arms. These are just two of the iconic paintings that artist Svetlana Petrova has reproduced with Zarathustra, her cat, stealing the show. The results look as if the cat has invaded the artwork to improve upon it, Petrova says. She admits to using a combination of her painting, photography, and digital talents to create her unique works of art—with the cat's permission, of course.

Tall dessert: Different countries have different kinds of warm weather dessert treats. A favorite in Japan is shaved ice. Hyakusho Udon, a restaurant in Miyazaki, presents its patrons with a really big version of this dessert—so big, in fact, that it has to be eaten standing up. That's because the shaved ice is piled in a bowl to a height of 634 millimeters (25 inches). This tower is then doused with the patron's chosen syrup flavor and finished off with a drizzle of condensed milk. The colorful treats look good, but they may be too big for one person. The restaurant suggests that diners may want to share it with a friend.

No noodles: Visitors to China's Beijing Zoo are being told to leave their noodles at home. Zookeepers discovered that people are slipping uncooked noodles to the monkeys through small vent holes at the bottom of the animals' glass enclosures. Zoo management isn't happy about it. They had already replaced bars in the cages with glass because people were feeding the monkeys all sorts of food through the bars. They also aren't pleased that visitors are offering noodles and other high-carbohydrate treats that are difficult for the monkeys to digest and could make them ill. The monkeys need a very specific diet, and noodles are definitely not on the menu.
