## Everybody's Talking!

**Miracle dog:** Gaspar is being called a miracle dog after he escaped from the cargo hold of an airplane. Janis Cavieres, the dachshund's owner, put her pet in a proper carrier, which was then placed in the hold of a flight from Santiago to Iquique, in northern Chile. The carrier fell out and broke open before the plane took off, and Gaspar escaped. The little dog wandered around in the Atacama Desert for several days before he was found via a search the owner organized on social media. A veterinarian said the dog was malnourished and underweight, but was going to be okay.

The first completed park boasted 139.35 square metres (1,500 sq. ft.) of habitat.
